

Prayer For Divine Love – with Bible Verses

Our Father, who are in heaven, we recognize that You are all holy and loving and merciful, and that we are Your children, and not the subservient, sinful and depraved creatures that our false teachers would have us believe. (Matt. 6:9; 1 John 3:1-2)

Mt 6:9 “This, then, is how you should pray: “Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name,

1 Jn 3:1-2 How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. Dear friends, now we are children of God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But when it is made known, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is.

That we are the greatest of Your creation, and the most wonderful of all Your handiworks, and the objects of Your great Soul’s Love and tenderest care. (Psalm 139:13-18)

Ps 139:13 For you created my inmost being; you knit me together in my mother’s womb.

Ps 139:14 I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; your works are wonderful, I know that full well.

Ps 139:15 My frame was not hidden from you when I was made in the secret place. When I was woven together in the depths of the earth,

Ps 139:16 your eyes saw my unformed body. All the days ordained for me were written in your book before one of them came to be.

Ps 139:17 How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast is the sum of them!

Ps 139:18 Were I to count them, they would outnumber the grains of sand. When I awake, I am still with you.

That Your will is that we become at one with You, and partake of Your great Love which You have bestowed upon us through Your mercy and desire that we become, in truth, Your children, through Love, and not through the sacrifice and death of any one of Your creatures. (John 17:11, 20-26).

Jn 17:11 I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name—the name you gave me—so that they may be one as we are one....

Jn 17:20 “My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message,

Jn 17:21 that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.

Jn 17:22 I have given them the glory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one:

Jn 17:23 I in them and you in me. May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.

Jn 17:24 “Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world.

Jn 17:25 “Righteous Father, though the world does not know you, I know you, and they know that you have sent me.

Jn 17:26 I have made you known to them, and will continue to make you known in order that the love you have for me may be in them and that I myself may be in them.”

We pray that You will open up our souls to the inflowing of Your Love, and that then may come Your Holy Spirit to bring into our souls this, Your Love in great abundance, until our souls shall be transformed into the very essence of Yourself; and that there may come to us faith – such faith as will cause us to realize that we are truly Your children and one with You in very substance and not in image only. (Rom 5:5; 1 John 4:7, 12-13, 16-17)

Ro 5:5 And hope does not disappoint us, because God has poured out his love into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, whom he has given us.

1Jn 4:7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God. ...

1Jn 4:12-13 No one has ever seen God; but if we love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us. We know that we live in him and he in us, because he has given us of his Spirit. ...

1Jn 4:16-17 And so we know and rely on the love God has for us. God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in him. In this way, love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment, because in this world we are like him.

Let us have such faith as will cause us to know that You are our Father, and the bestower of every good and perfect gift, and that only we, ourselves, can prevent Your Love changing us from the mortal to the immortal. (Jas 1:17- 18) Let us never cease to realize that Your Love is waiting for each and all of us, and that when we come to You, in faith and earnest aspiration, Your Love will never be withheld from us. (Luke 11:13)

Jas 1:17-18 Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows.

Lk 11:13 If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him!"

Keep us in the shadow of Your Love every hour and moment of our lives, and help us to overcome all temptations of the flesh, and the influence of the powers of the evil ones, which so constantly surround us and endeavor to turn our thoughts away from You to the pleasures and allurements of this world. (Matt. 6:13; Jas 1:13-15)

Mt 6:13 And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.

Jas 1:13-15 When tempted, no one should say, "God is tempting me." For God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does he tempt anyone; but each one is tempted when, by his own evil desire, he is dragged away and enticed. Then, after desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, gives birth to death.

We thank You for Your Love and the privilege of receiving it, and we believe that You are our Father — the loving Father who smiles upon us in our weakness, and is always ready to help us and take us into Your arms of Love. (Luke 15:11-32)

Ps 103:13-14 As a father has compassion on his children, so the LORD has compassion on those who fear [deeply respect] him; for he knows how we are formed, he remembers that we are dust.

Luke 15:11-32 – Parable of the Prodigal Son.

We pray this with all the earnestness and longings of our souls, and trusting in Your Love, give You all the glory and honor and love that our finite souls can give. Amen. (1 Tim. 1:17; Eph. 3:20-21)

1Ti 1:17 Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, the only God, be honor and glory for ever and ever. Amen.

Eph. 3:20-21 Now to him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, according to his power that is at work within us to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen.
